### 【授業内容とその進め方】

This class will be organized as a seminar, rather than as a lecture. There is a great deal of theory related to second language acquisition. However, this class will focus on data, with theory only being introduced when it is necessary.

The primary data that we will use in the class will be recordings of Nori (pseudonym), a middle-aged Japanese man living in Honolulu. Students will be asked to transcribe part of these recordings. Based on what we are able to find in the data, we will attempt to build a model of the process of Nori's acquisition of English. Finally, students will use these transcriptions for a research project, in which they investigate some feature of Nori's developing English ability. The research project will include writing a report and giving a brief presentation.
