### 【授業内容とその進め方】

This class is designed to develop and extend the reading, writing and speaking skills you learned in the spring term. The first half of the course will review different kinds of reading, such as explanation, opinion, research and graphs. The second half of the course will focus on using reading and writing skills to make a spoken presentation. Students will be shown how to organize their language to do this, focussing on how to present a formal spoken argument. Then students will learn basic presentation skills such as vocalizing, eye contact, posture and using visuals. Finally, students will make a presentation on a topic of their choice. There is no textbook. All materials will be provided by the teacher. The class will be taught in English.
