<b>【授業内容とその進め方】</b>
<p>This course is not a lecture-oriented course but a student-centered course. You will be involved in various kinds of group as well as individual work and projects. Cooperative learning is a crucial concept and principle for students to follow. Students will also need to contribute to class reading materials and work at home on various kinds of research and preparation in the forms of homework.</p> <p>This course is an English-only course but allows occasional meaningful use of Japanese in class. Japanese support in class and outside of class by the professor is available upon request.</p>

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### 【成績評価方法及び評価基準(最低達成基準を含む)】

This course adopts an accumulative grading system which divides the final grades into percentages. It is important to note that there will NOT be a final test that counts for 100% of your grade.

Attendance: 40%

Reading seminars: 10%

Presentation: 30%

Small reading exams: 10%

Class participation: 10%

However, any students who miss 4 classes WITHOUT any excuses will fail the course automatically. Students who miss 2 or more classes without excuses will not be able to get "S" grade.
