There are two major objectives of this class. The first is to develop and improve academic English skills, especially skills related to reading, writing, discussion, and note-taking. The second is to learn how conversations in English are structured. This will be accomplished through the study of research in the field of conversation analysis(会話分析).

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【授業内容とその進め方】

Class activities will consist of lectures related to the readings, small group and class discussions related to the readings, and hands-on practice in analyzing brief segments of conversations in English. Students will be expected to take notes during the lectures and participate fully in the discussions and practice activities. Students will also be assigned material to read as homework. This material will be from the textbook and other sources. There will be three take-home examinations which will involve the writing of analyses of segments of English conversations.

Grades will be based on participation in class and on satisfactory completion of the take-home examinations. Participation will be worth 10% of the grade. Each take-home examination will be worth 30% of the grade.
