【主題および達成目標】
<p>Academic Reading, Writing and Presentation</p> <p>This course aims to provide students with the opportunities to study both academic reading and academic presentation skills through small-group and class discussions, seminars and presentations. The themes of the course are designed by both the professor and students, including current topics of the society, education, news, sports, health and politics.</p> <p>The writing component of the course starts with introduction of basic concepts of academic writing at paragraph level and proceed to a short essay at the end of the course. In addition, writing for academic communication such as emailing and impromptu writing for academic discussion on the internet will be included.</p>

【教科書等】
None. The course uses authentic materials in English from various sources: newspapers, magazines, textbooks, internet, academic books, etc. Most of the materials will be prepared by the professor, but students are also given opportunities to bring their own materials to class for discussion and/or presentation.

【授業内容とその進め方】

This course is not a lecture-oriented course but a student-centered course. You will be involved in various kinds of group as well as individual work and projects. Cooperative learning is a crucial concept and principle for students to follow. Students will also need to contribute to class reading materials and work at home on various kinds of research and preparation in the forms of homework.

This course is an English-only course but allows occasional meaningful use of Japanese in class. Japanese support in class and outside of class by the professor is available upon request.

【成績評価方法及び評価基準(最低達成基準を含む)】

This course adopts an accumulative grading system which divides the final grades into percentages. It is important to note that there will NOT be a final test that counts for 100% of your grade.
