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【主題および達成目標】
<p>Theme: To read articles on science, sum up and estimate them, hopefully, in English. By "hopefully" I mean that I will encourage you to give your idea in English as best as you can. I don't blame you even when you express yourself mostly in Japanese.</p> <p>Goal: 1) To grasp how an article is structured: it is composed of the author's idea or conclusion and supporting evidence. 2) To be able to estimate the article, in other words, to be able to give your ideas of what the article deals with. 3) To be able to grasp what the article's conclusion is in relatively a short time without depending much on a dictionary.</p>

【授業内容とその進め方】

Class goes mostly in English: Basically I speak English slowly, but sometimes in Japanese.

You are encouraged to speak English, but I do not blame you when you do not.

Each time class is composed of three processes:

- 1) A quiz or vocabulary check from the textbook mentioned above, e.g. Congress 意味()
- 2) To read and discuss an article.

Let me give you an example. Suppose we read an article on global warming.

First, you are asked to make out what the author thinks of the phenomenon, how she or he justifies her or his conclusion. Then you are encouraged to estimate how far the author's logic or thinking process is reasonable.

This is my first attempt. I am afraid we will have to go in a "trial and error" way.

All you need is the willingness and enthusiasm with which to make yourself improve.
