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【主題および達成目標】
The three overall goals of this course are: 1) to become fluent readers of English, 2) to learn how to express and support opinions in spoken and written English, and 3) to develop good self-study habits.

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【授業内容とその進め方】

There are three components: reading, opinions, and self-study. The first part of each class will be used for reading. I will bring books to class for students to read. The second part of each class will be used for discussions, based on the textbook. As a class, students will choose which topics from the textbook they want to use. For homework, I will assign questions for students to answer in their journals. Finally, students will be asked to use the Language Self-Study Room for at least one hour a week for at least six weeks.

【成績評価方法及び評価基準(最低達成基準を含む)】

Grades will be based on a point system. Students can earn points for the following things:

1. Attendance and active participation, 0-30 points
2. Doing journal homework on time, 0-10 points
3. Quality of journal homework, 0-20 points
4. Using the Language Self-Study Room (言語自習室), 0-30 points
5. Doing autonomous learning assignments, 0-10 points

The highest possible total is 100 points. Students who earn between 90 and 100 points will receive a grade of S (秀); those who earn between 80 and 89 points will receive a grade of A (優); those who earn between 70 and 79 points will receive a grade of B (良); those who earn between 60 and 69 points will receive a grade of C (可); those who earn between 0 and 59 points will receive a grade of D (不可).

Students with more than four unexcused absences will not be able to pass the class. Being late three times will be counted as one absence. Students who have a good reason for being absent or late should inform me in a timely manner.
