### 【授業内容とその進め方】

The content of this class is the history of the Vietnam War, which students will learn about through reading and watching a movie. However, this is an English class, not a history class. Through this class, students will improve their reading fluency and develop strategies for effective reading. They will also improve their ability to write in English, specifically, to summarize, explain, and evaluate in writing. Finally, they will learn vocabulary used in written English as well as vocabulary related to the content.

Students will be given time to read the textbook during class. They will be given writing assignments to complete in their journal. (The journal is a notebook which students will use to do these writing assignments.)

We will also watch one movie, "Born on the Fourth of July."

### 【成績評価方法及び評価基準(最低達成基準を含む)】

Grades will be based on participation in class and on the journal writing assignments.

Completing the journal assignments on time: 20%

Quality of journal assignments, including improvement: 40%

Participation in class: 40%

Students with more than four unexcused absences will not be able to pass the class. Being late three times will be counted as one absence. Students who have a good reason for being absent or late should inform me in a timely manner.
