The purpose of this class is to learn how to write an academic paper in English. The focus is on the writing process, which involves developing and discussing ideas, writing preliminary drafts, receiving feedback, revising, and editing.

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【授業内容とその進め方】

The way that this class will proceed is somewhat unusual. During the course of the semester, the students will go through the process of writing an academic paper. We will not meet as a class every week. While the class will meet during certain weeks, other weeks will be devoted to conferences between me and individual students. By having these conferences, I will be able to give each student useful, individualized instruction.
