【授業内容とその進め方】

The course will be divided into two parts. For the (approximately) first half of the semester, students will learn about theory, research, and issues in second/foreign language acquisition. Students will be assigned relatively brief readings for these topics. The second half of the semester will be used for a class project in which students will work with data from a learner of English as a second language. (However, students will also do work to prepare for the class project during the first half of the semester.) During the course of the semester, there will be three essay-type take-home examinations.

【成績評価方法及び評価基準(最低達成基準を含む)】

Ten percent of the grade will be based on active participation. Thirty percent will be based on the student's contribution to the class project. The rest of the grade will be based on three take-home examinations. The weighting for each take-home examination will be between 10% and 40%. Each student will be able to decide the exact weighting for each examination.

Students with more than four unexcused absences will not be able to pass the class. Being late three times will be counted as one absence. Students who have a good reason for being absent or late should inform me in a timely manner.

【オフィスアワー：授業相談】

My official office hours are Tuesday, 3rd period (火曜3限). However, I am often in my office and students are welcome to see me at other times. Students may also contact me through e-mail.

【学生へのメッセージ】

Second/foreign language acquisition is an important field to learn about. By studying this field, students will be better able to understand their own position as language learners and their rights and obligations as second language users of English (and other languages).
