【主題および達成目標】

The general goal of this class is for students to learn to communicate in English in a variety of computer-mediated environments.

【授業内容とその進め方】

Two important aspects of this class are cooperative learning and computer-mediated communication. Students will form small groups (3-5 students) that will work together for the whole semester. Each group will choose two topics to work on during the semester. During class, groups will find information about their topic on the Internet and will discuss their topic using chat software. At the end of the semester, each group will prepare and give a presentation related to one of their topics, using Power Point software. Outside of class, students will discuss their topics using a dedicated bulletin board (BBS). Also, I will give assignments to each group by e-mail.

【成績評価方法及び評価基準(最低達成基準を含む)】

Grades will be based on participation in and completion of class activities and out-of-class assignments. The different activities and assignments will be weighted as follows:

Class participation (web searches, chat discussions): 40% Bulletin board (BBS) participation: 20% E-mail assignments: 20% Group presentation: 20%

Students with more than four unexcused absences will not be able to pass the class. Being late three times will be counted as one absence. Students who have a good reason for being absent or late should inform me in a timely manner.
